Dear partners,

The Palmetto Equestrian Therapeutic Riding Program is a nonprofit organization that provides educational, therapeutic, and recreational opportunities with the interaction of horses for children and adults with special needs to develop or increase cognitive, physical, social, and/or emotional skills. To increase academic skills, therapeutic riding motivates students to learn and may improve memory and attention span. Thus, educational goals are incorporated into riding activities. Physically, the horse's movement can stimulate riders' bodies in a manner that closely resembles the gait of a human. This motion increases riders' muscle tone, relaxes tight muscles, increases muscle flexibility and joint mobility, and improves posture, balance, and coordination. The horse's movement, also, provides vestibular stimulation to the rider, which can help mitigate sensory integration issues. Holding the reins and manipulating various objects with the hands can improve fine motor control, hand/eye coordination, and spatial awareness. Socially, therapeutic riding allows riders the opportunity to form relationships with horses, volunteers, and other riders that help to develop/improve confidence, patience, and self-esteem. Activities enable riders to learn effective and appropriate communication, as well as, develop teamwork through interactions with their peers. Emotionally, therapeutic riding provides a non-competitive setting for learning new skills, responsibility, and self-discipline; as well as, overcoming fear and anxiety: all which increase a rider's self-esteem and independence.

The PET Riding Program depends on donations to provide funds for sponsorships for participants, horse feed and care, program needs, and sponsorships for fundraising events.
